InterChange Group Warehouses

1.6 MW (2019)

In 2019, Secure Solar Futures installed **1.6 megawatts** of solar power generating capacity on rooftops of four warehouse locations owned and operated by InterChange Group. The company is a regional third-party logistics provider.

Its facilities include cold storage warehouses with significant power usage.

Consisting of a total of 4,698 solar panels altogether, the four solar arrays offset 45% of the electric power used by all four sites combined. In one year, that's the same amount of electricity used in 288 homes.

For the facilities in the first phase of solar, their power usage in 2018 versus 2019 only increased by 0.035%, yet their annual electric bill went down by \$135,518.442. In just one year, that represents a decline of 32% in electricity costs. Through co-investing in the solar project, InterChange was able to realize a one-time return on its capital of more than 40%, made possible by effectively leveraging federal tax incentives.
